In the UK jewellery industry, sizes have been standardised so how we ask for your measurement will be standard sizing across most jewellers. Ring sizes are measured using the circumference of your finger so you'll often find length in mm as well as lettercharts.

When wearing rings, size should fit snugly, and never tight that you struggle to take the ring off, and never too loose that it slips up the finger and risk falling off without you knowing. It is therefore important to get the sizing right so we hope that this guide will assist you an make the process easier when you are purchasing on line.

There are a few ways in which you can work out your size Jewellers have ring sizers that you can reference ring size, which you can purchase on line or visit the studio if you are local. However, there are a couple of methods which we recommend using if you can not access us directly.

One main tip which we always advise is to triple check your measurements, and if measuring around your finger you might find it easier if someone helps to achieve a more accurate reading.
